## The following admissions criteria apply:

### Students must:

- Be on the NMC register working in a critical care environment (level 2/3)
- Have 12 months' experience within critical care
- Have successfully completed Step 1 competencies as outlined in the National Critical Care Competency Framework (2015)
- Work a minimum number of clinical hours during the course of the programme (18 hours per week)
- Be able to demonstrate the ability to study at the chosen academic level
- Meet University requirements for English qualification (Grade C in GCSE English Language or equivalent. For international students, equivalent qualifications would be: IELTS of 6.5 overall with no lower than 6 in any component)
- Have approval from line manager and unit education team
