The following admissions criteria apply:

Applicants must:

- Provide evidence of current Healthcare registration
- Have successfully completed a period of locally agreed preceptorship
- Be up to date with Mandatory Training, Equipment Training and Fit Tested
- Complete the pre-course competencies (Step 1)
- Work a minimum number of clinical hours during the course of the programme (three short shifts or two long days per week)
- Have worked in their current clinical environment for a minimum of 12 months prior to accessing the course
- 40% of clinical practice hours should allow for contact with a mentor / supervisor over the duration of the course. This will allow for supported clinical practice, review, and assessment of personal progress for the duration of study
- Have approval from line manager and unit education
- Be able to demonstrate the ability to study at the chosen academic level via the pre-course 500 word written exercise - further information can be found
