## INFECTION CONTROL PRECAUTIONS

## **Before Every Patient Contact**

- ♦ Essential staff only allowed in infected areas
- ♦ Hand Hygiene 1. before touching patient; 2. before clean or aseptic procedure; 3. after body fluid exposure 4. after touching patient; 5. after touching surroundings.
- ♦ Put on eye protection, gown/aprons and gloves.

## If Using Aerosol Generating Procedures

(e.g. intubation, bronchoscopy, CRR, Suction)

- ♦ Perform procedure in adequately ventilated room
- ♦ Put on a gown
- ♦ Put on a particular respirator (e.g. FFP3, US NIOSH-certified N95) if available
